**3.** Permission will be requested to conduct a capital campaign to receive pledges for the work proposed in Phase I.

4. Permission will be requested to allow our architect to develop construction documents.

# IF THE PROPOSAL BEFORE THE CHURCH CONFERENCE IS APPROVED ON JUNE 27, WHAT HAPPENS NEXT?

**1.** Construction drawings and the capital campaign will be done over the summer.

**2.** Formal bidding will occur in the fall.

3. A final set of informational meetings and a church conference to seek final approval on the project will be held before the end of the year.

4. Construction would commence in early 2018 and be completed by August 2018.

## HAS ANYTHING SIGNIFICANT CHANGED SINCE THE FEBRUARY CHURCH CONFERENCE?

Yes, because of the additional elements added into the project to meet concerns previously raised, the overall square footage has increased about 2,500 square feet. This will increase the financial support needed.

### DO WE KNOW THE COST OF PHASE !?

At the time of printing our updated cost estimates indicate that construction management, design fees, equipment and furnishings, and contingency at approximately, \$3,125,000. We will continue to hone this figure as further design and costing is done.

### HOW MUCH DEBT DOES CENTRAL HAVE?

Central has two notes payable, one for \$1.65 million related to the Student Ministries Building/Parking Deck and another for \$2.9 million related to the post office property which total approximately \$4.55 million. The total annual principal and interest payments are \$423,000, however the lease on the post office covers about \$124,000 of the payments, leaving about \$299,000 to be paid by Central's operating budget annually. This represents about 6% of Central's budget.
