# VACCINATIONS FOR COLOMBIA

Immunization Information for Peru and Colombia (You may find current information on these countries at [www.cdc.gov](http://www.cdc.gov). Vaccines should be completed 4 to 6 weeks before your trip.)

Make sure you are up-to-date on routine vaccines before every trip. These vaccines include measles-mumps-rubella (MMR) vaccine, diphtheria-tetanus-pertussis vaccine, varicella (chickenpox) vaccine, polio vaccine, and your yearly flu shot.

1. Make sure you are up to date on routine vaccinations such as measles-mumps-rubella, diphtheria-tetanus-pertussis, chicken pox, polio and yearly flu shot
2. Hepatitis A
3. Typhoid
4. Hepatitis B (for contact with needles, or blood products, or before any medical procedures)
5. Malaria preventive tablets
6. Yellow Fever
7. Rabies (vaccine optional)
