#### **GROWING IN CHRIST**

Believer growing in Christ primarily through large group experiences while developing a heart for the needs of others.

#### **CLOSE TO CHRIST**

Mature believer who desires a deeper level of shared life with others while also seeking ways to unselfishly serve.

# **CHRIST-CENTERED**

Christ-centered believer who consistently surrenders to God's will, reproduces the Christian faith in the life of others and lives a life of service.

#### **Prayers & Personal** Devotional **Practices**

- When I pray, I focus on my needs.
- · I seek to grow closer to God through prayer.
- · Lask God for things or circumstances that I desire.
- · I seldom read the Bible.
- I acknowledge my sin and have received God's forgiveness.
- · I thank God for who He is and what He is doing in my life.
- · I pray occasionally to seek God's direction for my life.
- I pray occasionally for other people.
- · I read the Bible occasionally to know God, the truth, and find direction for my life.
- · I pray regularly with others.
- I pray regularly for the church, the city, the poor and the persecuted.
- · I engage in spiritual disciplines like fasting. journaling, solitude, Sabbath, scripture memorization, etc.
- · I experience times of solitude to listen to God's direction
- · I connect with God in a powerful way through prayer, solitude and/or Scripture.
- · I am disciplined in my spiritual practices.
- I regularly read the Bible to apply God's teachings to my life.

- · I pray daily with others.
- · I pray daily for the church, the city, the poor and the persecuted.
- · I pray for people I do not know.
- I view prayer as a constant conversation with God, as opposed to a specific time.
- I experience an ongoing dialogue with God throughout my day.
- . I read the Bible daily to deepen my relationship with God.

#### Presence through **Worship & Growth** Groups\*

- Growth Groups include Sunday School classes, Disciple Bible studies, Wednesday Night Live classes, men's and women's studies, etc.
- Attending worship is not a high priority.

- · Attending worship is a high priority (three out of four Sundays).
- · I expect to enter the presence of God when I worship.
- · I allow other Christians to hold me accountable for my actions.
- · I regularly (three out of four weeks) attend a Growth Group.
- · I practice my faith every day of the week.
- · Attending worship is my top priority therefore I attend every Sunday I am physically able.
- My worship is not compromised by secular mind sets. I worship to glorify God, no matter what the music style, atmosphere or sermon topic may be.
- · My Growth Group is an essential part of my weekly life.

# Gifts through **Tithes & Offerings**

- · I give as I am able.
